

Problem Statement

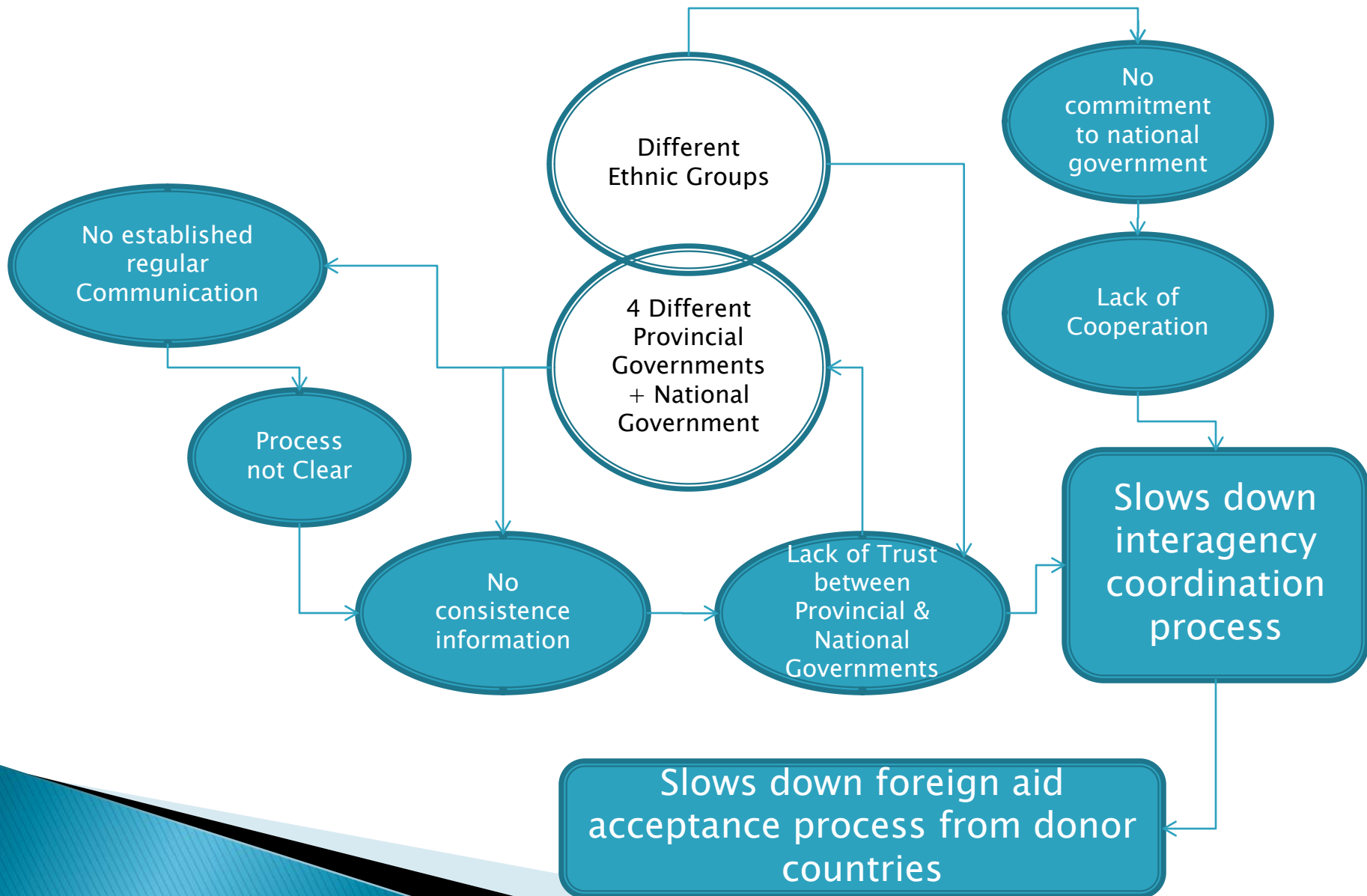
Slow and inefficient interagency processes between the National Government and 4 Provincial Governments jeopardize future foreign aid funded by international donors

Goal and Supporting Objectives

▶ Goal

- Clear, efficient, and synchronized processes within Provincial and National Governments to accept aid from international donors


▶ Supporting Objectives

1. Increase cooperation between 4 Provincial Governments and the National Government to improve acceptance of foreign aid.
2. Educate and train provincial government officials on new interagency processes in accepting foreign aid and projects.

Action Plan in Support of Objective 1

- ▶ To increase cooperation between the Provincial Governments and the National Government
 1. I will draft a proposal to the national government to fund representatives from the provinces to travel to the capital: (30 days)
 - a) To attend regular meetings to increase dialogue
 - b) To attend specific meetings to discuss allocation and distribution of foreign aid
 2. I will recruit representatives from the provincial and the national governments to establish a committee. (60 days)

Action Plan in Support of Objective 2

- ▶ To educate and train provincial governments officials
 1. I will create a manual of standard operating procedures (SOP) for receiving, processing, allocation, and distributing foreign aid within the national government agencies and provincial governments. Obtain approval for the SOP. (60 days)
 2. The committee will develop a training program based on the SOP to train newly hired staff of all the agencies and provincial government on the process of allocating and distributing foreign aid. Obtain approval for the training program. (6 months)

Action Plan in Support of Objective 2

- ▶ To educate and train provincial governments officials
 1. I will obtain funding for the training program (1 year)
 - a) Funding for travel expenses for the trainers
 - b) Funding for equipment such as computers and stationary supplies
 2. The committee oversees implementation of training program: (1 year)
 - a) A team from the national government to regularly travel to the provinces and present how national government processes, allocates, and distribute foreign aid to various agencies.
 - b) The team member explains the requirements for the provincial government officials to expeditiously receive the aid from the relevant national agencies.

Measures of Success

- Reduced complication between national and provincial agencies on implementation of donated projects.
 - Reduce the average time required to achieve agreement between national and provincial agencies from 6 months to 3 months.
 - Increased number of donor-funded projects implemented by 50% within 2 years.
